 - e. Hired Todd Mann Management Group to design and build a new website under the direction of the Media and Publications Advisory Committee (MPAC).

Because the election slate was found not to be compatible with our Constitution, the Executive Board has approved a new elections schedule:

- March 14th: Nominating Committee sends Executive Director nomination report

- March 21st-April 18th: Publish nomination slate; open petition period
- May 9th-May 23rd: Elections
- June 1: Publish results
- July 1: New Board convenes
