



3. When you enter the session, the screen will be dark if no one is sharing a camera. You might see a welcome page or sponsor information.



At the bottom of your screen are buttons to turn on/off your microphone + camera, to share your screen, or to raise your hand.

4. When you click on your camera icon, you have the option to select video quality and blur your background.



Tip: Higher video quality and blurring your background can create lags between your speech and what others see. Using lower-quality resolution and no blur is a good idea if your internet isn't super fast.

5. When you click on the computer icon (see the previous slide), you can share a slide deck or images if you have them. Click on “share all or part of your screen”.


6. When you're done sharing your screen, click "stop sharing" at the top of the screen.
